This year one of our math goals is to teach students how to effectively use online learning resources. Such resources will provide students with additional math skills' practice and also allow me to individualize each student's learning experience.

Khan Academy is a well-researched, free, online tool that will allow your child the ability to get math support from now through their college years. For more information please visit the website:

Each math student will be required to have a Kahn Academy account in class by Friday, September 5th, 2014. If your child is under 13 years of age, he/she will need to have a parents email address so that the Kahn Academy can send those parents an email with instructions to continue setting up their child's account.

As your child's coach, I will be assigning homework on Kahn Academy and likewise will be able to monitor his/her progress, strengths and weaknesses. If your child does not have internet access they will be encouraged to come into the math lab to complete their work. Time will also be allocated during class time.

Students will earn 10 points for their first assignment, which is to have their Kahn Academy account setup by Friday, September 5th.
